9	For what purpose or project is the grant requested?	The grant is to be used to pay for goals and equipment essential for the training and playing of matches, such as but not limited to:
		First aid kits Various sized footballs (required due to different age groups) 2 sets of goals Pitch marker cones Training equipment. Training bibs

10	What are the project's aims?	Our aim is to provide a fun, safe, and affordable environment for local children to develop friendships, engage in healthy physical activity and competition in the local community.
		This will be achieved by setting up a local youth football club for children of Cranbrook and the immediately surrounding area.
		The first phase of this project will be the formation of four teams across two age groups.

		The teams will be training and playing matches at the local St Martins school with aspirations of utilising the Ingrams development once construction is complete. Our aspirations are that we can positively contribute to what we hope will become a hub of local sports in the community at the Ingrams. We plan to do this by continuing to provide opportunities to the current U9 & 10s teams to play as they age and progress through the age groups.
		We will also look to provide guidance and assistance to any other local Cranbrook community members to set up future teams under the umbrella of the new club as the seasons and years progress.

11	Please evidence demand for this project:	The club already has nearly fifty local children signed up across the two age groups with four teams excited for the new season of football.

12	If the total cost of the project is more than the grant, how will the residue be financed?	The ongoing costs of the club will be financed by monthly subscriptions which will be charged for ten out of twelve months of the year.

13	How is financial sustainability being achieved in the long term?	As above with the player's monthly subscriptions and ad-hoc sponsorship from local businesses that are associated with the club via parents or being part of the local community.
		The sponsorship is not required for the financial sustainability of the club and would normally be used for isolated purchases, such as new match and training kits.

	If sponsorship is not forthcoming in
	future seasons the club would mitigate this by recycling previous seasons kits down to the lower age groups and purchasing a single kit for the eldest age group. This is a very unlikely scenario but one we have considered to make sure all known financial eventualities are planned for.
	We have also considered the potential of interclub fundraiser events if needed.
	The final option would be to increase the player's monthly subscriptions. With the current cost of living crisis that is affecting many families in the area and across the country one of our main objectives is to keep the cost for the families down.
	We believe cost shouldn't be a barrier to entry in junior sports.
	We plan to be transparent with all stake holders of the club regarding the finances with clear, complete annual reports. The efficient management of grant funding and parents' subscriptions is not a responsibility the committee take lightly.
